The fees below are for the year to 31 December 2008. A pro rata reduction may apply depending on when in the year membership starts. PHONE 0116 270 4188 FOR CURRENT COST.

Family	£140
Single	£110
Young Adult (18-24 inc)	£55
Social	£30
1st Craft/Sailboard	£40
2nd & subsequent boats (each)	£30
Trailer (if not under boat)	£15
Joining Fee* (Family/single/young adult categories)	*£30

* A joining fee of £30 is payable in the first year of membership only.

NB. Joining fee is not payable if Junior/Family member is transferring to Young Adult.

To calculate the total fee due, select the appropriate category of membership required, and add the fees due for the number of craft/trailers you wish to register. (Register only one sailboard regardless of how many boards you own and sail).

20% discount on the above fees (except trailer) applies to Senior Citizens.
Affiliated membership may be available to groups, societies or clubs by application.

NOTES

DUTIES:

SINGLE/YOUNG ADULT MEMBERS are required to carry out two full days per year, i.e. 2 Sundays or 4 Saturdays, Tuesdays or Thursdays.

FAMILY/AFFILIATED MEMBERS are required to carry out four full days per year, i.e. 4 Sundays or 8 Saturdays, Tuesdays or Thursdays. Two members must be available for duty. If this causes concern please contact the Duty Co-ordinator.

SOCIAL members are not required to do duties – but please feel free to volunteer!

It is your responsibility to contact the Duty Co-ordinator if you are unable to do your duty. He will assist you to make alternative arrangements. Please remember, the club cannot operate without a duty crew. Every effort is made to keep your duties to a minimum but your support is essential to enable the club to function.

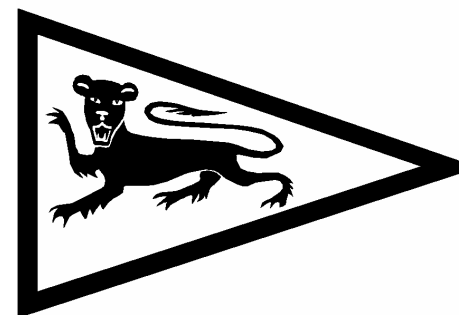
Duty Officer and Safety Boat crew must be over the age of 18, unless qualified.

When you register a boat/sailboard a sticker will be issued which must be attached to your craft so that it is visible when the craft is parked. This identifies the craft as registered with the club. Craft not displaying a current year's sticker may be impounded at any time during the season.
